

Bike a segment or several, or do the complete end-to-end.

Wear a helmet. Bring spare tubes, patch kit, water, and nutrition. Obey all traffic and cycling rules. This self-supported casual group ride is not insured. We can transport post-ride bags. Potluck to follow.

>> ROUTE:

- **START:** 7 am at **Dry Cave/Haena Beach Park**. Follow Kuhio Hwy until crossing to make a left onto the coastal path at north side of Kealia and continue toward Kapa`a.
- 1st Stop: Kapa`a Neighborhood Center. Continue on path to Kuhio Hwy, Kapule Hwy, then turn left onto Rice Street, and continue downhill to back of Harbor Mall.
- 2nd Stop: Briggs Bikes, Harbor Mall, Nawiliwili. Continue west then turn left onto Wa`apa Road, pass the harbor, and turn right on Hulemalu Rd. Ride up past Menehune Fishpond. At the end of Hulemalu Rd., carefully turn left to go west on Kaumuali`i Hwy. Turn right into the lot by the Lawai post office and 7-11.
- **3rd Stop: Lawai 7-11/Post office.** Continue west. After Kalaheo, move to left turn lane at Halewili Road (a.k.a. Numila, New Mill Hill, Coffee Road). At end of Halewili, carefully turn left to rejoin Kaumuali`i Hwy. Continue to Waimea then follow the coast to....
- 4th Stop: Lis & Steve Layne's House, 8655 Kaumualii Hwy., Kehaha. After a break, start climbing Koke'e Road to Kanaloahuluhulu Meadow in Koke'e. Go as far up as you want then ride back down to Layne's. *Alternate route:* Ride the flat Mana plain out and back to Layne's.
- FINISH / Potluck at Lis & Steve Layne's House.
